## Policy on Immunization Requirements All Students

### I. Purpose

To reduce the incidence and risk of vaccine preventable diseases in the university community.

Establish operating procedures through a communicable diseases protocol.

### II. Scope

This policy shall be implemented for all students attending Alliant International University. Students need to provide proof of their vaccinations with their enrollment materials. These records will be kept in a confidential place in the office of the Director of Campus Services (at the Health Center for San Diego) after admission to the University.

Entities exempted from this policy are: Students only taking classes on line.

Proof of having had the disease or proof of having had the vaccination of the following diseases is required:

1. Measles
2. Mumps
3. Chicken pox
4. German measles (Rubella)
5. Meningitis
6. Polio
7. Tetanus shot within 10 years
8. Negative PPD (Tuberculosis skin test) or negative chest x-ray within 1 year

### III. Objectives

Prevention of communicable diseases.

Provide guidance and information to the campus community.

IV. Policy and Procedure

- A. Students will provide the proof of vaccinations or evidence of having had the disease from his or her outside healthcare provider at registration. For international students the request for proof of vaccination is included with the I-20 form.
- B. International students from campuses other than San Diego will submit their completed immunization forms to the Director of Campus Services (DCS).
- C. For residential students, the request for proof of vaccinations will be included in the housing contract. Once the documentation is obtained, it can be kept confidentially in the Health Services office or by the DCS. Either the DCS or the Director of Health Services will insure that the students can get copies of their documentation if needed in the future for practicums or clinical placements.
- D. The Director of Health Services will provide information on the above diseases to the university community and reinforce the necessity of immunizations especially to students living in close proximity to each other.
- E. The Director of Health Services will provide "TDAP" (Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) vaccine to those students upon request or need.
- F. The Director of Health Services will provide tuberculosis testing (PPD) upon request or need.
